

#### **Emissions reduction targets**

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 568 tCO2e by 2027. This is a reduction of 10%.

# **Carbon Reduction Projects**

#### **Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives**

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2022 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes will be measured again this year.

We have undertaken the following initiatives, many of which will be ongoing to continue to reduce carbon emissions:-

We have established a Sustainability Council, a team of dedicated members who meet regularly to discuss and implement sustainability improvements.

Enhancing recycling practices - all paper and plastics are recycled.

Transitioning to a paperless office.

Promoting the use of reusables – there are sufficient mugs, glasses, and cutlery for everyone.

Given all employees' access to our electric vehicle scheme.

All company cars are now hybrid or fully electric.

Implemented a travel expenses policy to promote the most environmentally forms of travel and incentives lift-sharing.

Lobbied our landlord to move to the greenest energy provider possible - Brook Green Supply.

Partnering with a specialist carbon considerate office designer for the refit of the Bristol HQ, - this included furniture, flooring and finishes that were produced to the IS14001 standards, more PIR lighting controls and all LED lighting.

Our pension provider allows for investment in environmental considerate schemes.

We have provided donations to the value of c. £10,000 to the World Land Trust to support tree planting and biodiversity.

We have supported various other environmental projects such as beach cleaning.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

Committing to achieve the ISO 14001 environmental standard.
